

RODEO LEGISLATION – AUTHORS NEEDED

January 20, 2023 is the deadline for introducing new bills in the State Legislature. Below are four in need of an author:

- (1) Amend state rodeo law, Penal Code 596.7, so as to require ON-SITE veterinarians at all rodeos and charreadas--the "on call" option is not working and animals are suffering needlessly. Racetracks, horse shows, endurance rides and the PRCA all require on-site veterinarians. So should all rodeos and charreadas.
- (2) Ban tie-down calf roping, allowing "breakaway" roping only; Some vets claim the calves are injured EVERY time they're roped, thrown and tied--and mere BABIES, yet;
- (3) Ban the Mexican charreada's brutal "steer tailing" event (banned in Alameda & Contra Costa Counties, 1993/1994);
- (4) Ban the rodeo's non-sanctioned "wild cow milking contest," the children's "mutton busting" event, and animal "scrambles"--cruel and dangerous for all;
